Photographing your catch?
Remember to **Keep'em Wet!**

If you catch fish that are designated as catch & release, or fish you do not intend to eat, the Bonefish Bonnies join the OR Press in asking you not to remove them from the

water for a photo. Get creative and send in action pictures or pictures of your crew out on the water with a description of your fish. If you're fishing the flats, you might have the opportunity to jump in and hold your fish in the water. But use care in handling the fish.

Let your captains and mates know that as a Bonefish Bonnie you support the Keep Fish Wet organization which promotes the use of science-based best practices to catch, handle and release fish and that we follow their three principles of minimizing air exposure; eliminating contact with dry surfaces; and, reducing handling times.
