Gyotaku, February 10 The Art of Fish Printing

Join Board Member Mary Bloom and her lovely and talented assistant, Retired Board Member Diane Hill, on Friday, February 10th from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. at the Art League for an introduction to Gyotaku - the art of fish printing.

Learn about the ancient art and the techniques for commemorating your catch and making your own masterpieces.

Using non-toxic ink, Gyotaku is a way of "having your fish and eating it, too". Participants will be asked to bring a fish or the tail of a fish that has been kept for eating. 
