The "Lady Angler"

In early 2017, then-president, Mona Brewer, was approached by Nanette Elenbaas, who was the chairwoman of the ORCA Design Committee at the time, offering the Bonnies the opportunity to sponsor a bronze statue of an angler that would be a gift to the Ocean Reef community.

Mona and the Bonnies with help from friends in the community

raised the funds necessary to finance and commission the bronze statue created by renowned sculptor Gregory Johnson. The names of all the donors are listed alphabetically at the Bonefish Bonnies display in the Ocean Reef Cultural Center Museum.

In her remarks at the dedication on February 26, 2018, Mona stated that we were making history by dedicating the first commissioned statue of an angler given as a gift to the

Ocean Reef community and that in the United States only 9% of 6,900 recorded works of outdoor sculptures were of women.

She said, "In our small little way today at Ocean Reef we are changing history. What about Ocean Reef's new angler? Is this angler all about women? No I don't think so. After all there was a 50/50 chance it could be a woman or man. When the Bonnies were asked to help with this project...well...a woman it was."

Mona ended her remarks by saying, "This woman angler represents more than any one of us. She is all of us as a whole. If you are male or female, black or white, young or old, she represents the sport that is true and positive and cherished by many. She is dedicated to all aspiring anglers, new anglers and experienced anglers and may she inspire each of you, in your own way, to find joy in the sport of angling."

Members present at the dedication reported that the Bonnie spirit of camaraderie and sisterhood was palpable. Enjoy some of the photos from that day five years ago.
