Bonefish Bonnies Nominating Committee Report

<u>Article 5 Section 5.9</u> of the Bonefish Bonnies Bylaws states the responsibility and composition of the Nominating Committee.

"The Nominating Committee shall be responsible for identifying, screening and nominating prospective Club Members who are representative of the criteria for Board membership. The slate of candidates will be presented to the Board and the membership as set forth in Section 4.4 of these Bylaws. Annually, the President, with Board approval, shall appoint five (5) voting members to the Nominating Committee who shall include a minimum of two (2) members from the general membership not presently serving on the Board; a current Board member; and the immediate Past President of the Club who shall serve on the committee for a one-year term. The chairperson of the committee shall be the Club's Vice President. The current President may attend the meetings in an ex officio, non-voting capacity."

This season the Committee included *Angela Basciano* and *Kristine Vulgaris* from the general membership, current Board Member *Bonny Gothier*, Past President *Mary Bloom* and Vice President *DeeDee Lisenby* as chairperson. Current President *Laura Wilson* did attend as an ex officio, non-voting member.

<u>Article 4 Section 4.2</u> enumerates the qualifications that the Nominating Committee considers in their deliberations.

"Board members shall be chosen with a view toward maintaining a balanced Board, all of whom shall possess the skills and experience which contribute to the vision, mission and purpose of the Corporation and shall be Members of the Club in good standing who show a willingness to accept the responsibilities of serving as a member of the Board and have the time commitment to do so. The Directors shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for all necessary business expenses incurred in accordance with the Corporation's policies and procedures upon presentation of such supporting vouchers as may be required by the Corporation's policies."

<u>Article 4, Section 4.4</u> refers to the process of Nominations and Elections.

"Elections for vacancies on the Board shall be held at the Annual Meeting of the membership. At least sixty (60) days in advance of the Annual Meeting the President shall form, as set forth in Section 5.9 of these Bylaws, and subject to Board approval, a Nominating Committee to prepare a slate of qualified, willing Club members to serve on the Board. The slate is to be presented to the Board twenty-eight (28) days prior to the Annual Meeting and published in the Club's e-newsletter, Tight Lines, at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the Annual Meeting. Elections are presided over by the Vice President or another officer who is not on the current ballot and is appointed by the President. Only Club Members in good standing may vote. The slate will be approved by a show of hands of Members present at the Annual Meeting at which a quorum is present."

Accordingly, the Nominating Committee presents the slate of candidates for Board and Officer positions for the 2023 - 2024 Season. All terms are for two (2) years.


