

Something as simple as what shoes you are wearing while fishing can help prevent

injuries. Flip-Flops do not give you traction on a wet deck nor do they give you support when you are fighting a fish.

Make sure you know where the life preservers and life ring are whenever you are on someone else's boat whether it is a charter or privately owned.
