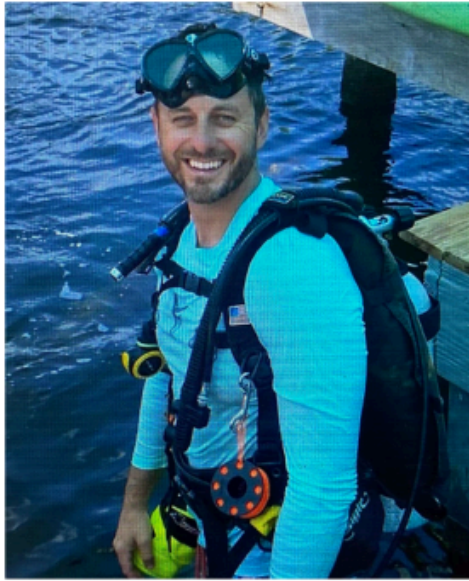

Make sure you know where the life preservers and life ring are whenever you are on someone else's boat whether it is a charter or privately owned.

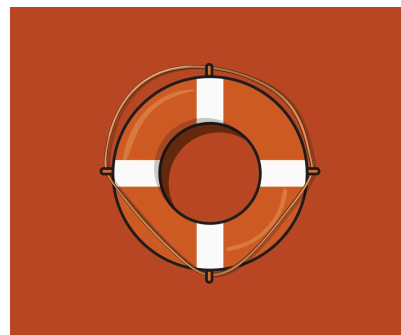
